
#### THE HISTORY

The Battle of Antietam was the first major confrontation



on Union soil with over 20,000 casualties on both sides. With the Battle of Antietam behind him, Confederate General Robert E. Lee retreated to Virginia to replenish supplies, rest his troops, reflect on the Union's next move, and prepare his own. Lee commanded General James Ewell Brown "J.E.B." Stuart to take 1,800 men to circle around General George McClellan and his Union troops

in Hagerstown, gather horses, supplies, and hostages, and disrupt functioning of the Cumberland Valley Railroad by destroying rail, bridges, and shops. Stuart's three-day raid garnered 1,200 horses, political hostages, and destroyed \$250,000 in military supplies and railroad property.
